Planted skips by students from the Royal College of Art appear at various locations around the Brompton Design District, bringing the crossover between art and horticulture to our streets.

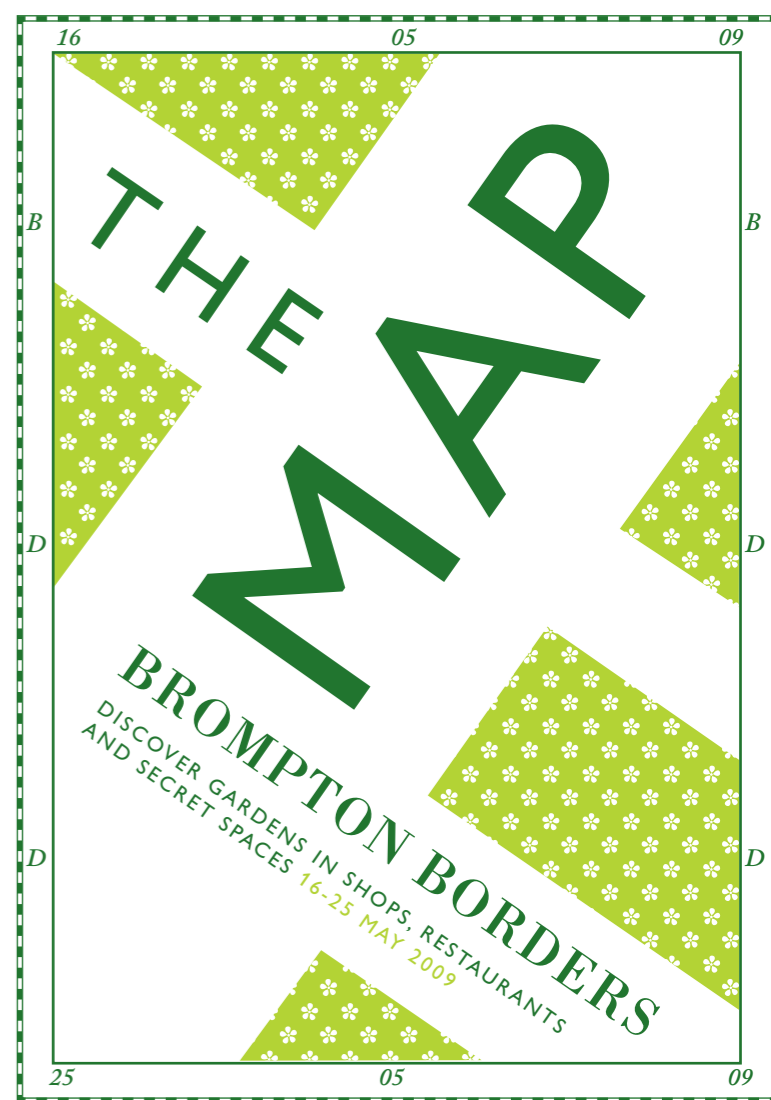
